

Calculate Your Savings with Central Coast Community Energy

Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) is your community-owned electricity provider offering clean and renewable energy at competitive rates for 32 Central Coast communities.

This worksheet will help you compare what you would be paying per month for PG&E electricity generation services to what you are paying for 3CE generation services.

Your Central Coast Community Energy electric charges will appear on your PG&E bill and you will receive a credit from PG&E on the bill since you are no longer purchasing its power. Below we explain how to calculate your savings.*

Please note: This form is only for use with residential PG&E customers using a statement dated after January 1, 2020.

As an 3Cchoice customer here's how you calculate your savings:

- 1 Enter "Generation Credit" usually found on page 3 of your bill.** You do not need to include the negative symbol. This is the generation fee now provided by 3CE's generation service, so PG&E credits this charge back to your account to avoid any duplication of generation fees. \$ _____

- 2 Enter additional charges from PG&E: Power Charge Indifference Adjustment and Franchise Fee Surcharge on page 3.** This covers energy purchased by PG&E on your behalf before you joined 3CE. \$ _____

- 3 Enter charges for Central Coast Community Energy, called "Net Charges" on page 4.** Other fees found here, which may include an Energy Commission Surcharge and sometimes a local Utility Users Tax, are paid by all PG&E customers and are not new since becoming a 3CE customer. \$ _____

- 4 Add the amount of the 3 lines from Step 2 and Step 3.** \$ _____
TOTAL CHARGES
- 5 Subtract the amount in Step 4 from the PG&E credit in Step 1 to see your savings.** \$ _____
