3CE Celebrates New Solar + Battery Storage



On Oct. 15, Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) joined project developer and owner Clearway Energy Group at the ribbon-cutting for the Arica and Victory Pass solar and storage projects. The celebration took place at the project site in Riverside County, CA, and included remarks from Congressman Dr. Raul Ruiz and from Leuwam Tesfai, CPUC Deputy Executive Director for Energy and Climate Policy.

The projects have a combined capacity of 463 MW solar and 186 MW battery storage, enough to power 205,000 homes. The electricity generated by Arica and Victory Pass will contribute to 3CE's renewable portfolio standards, while the battery storage will provide clean capacity to help meet resource adequacy requirements. The projects represent a \$1 billion investment in Riverside County and will contribute an estimated \$5.9 million in annual economic benefits. During construction, the projects created 1,000 union jobs.

Other CCAs investing in the projects and celebrating the ribbon-cutting include Clean Power Alliance (CPA), Peninsula Clean Energy (PCE) and Silicon Valley Clean Energy (SVCE).

3CE Launches New Bioenergy Opportunities Program

Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) is excited to announce a new program to help our Member Agencies achieve their legislatively mandated waste-diversion goals.

The Bioenergy Market Adjusting Tariff ([BioMAT](#)) Program is a CPUC procurement initiative to encourage the development of small bioenergy projects. Eligible generators can enter into a standard contract with 3CE at a price set by a market-based mechanism.

Eligible projects can include biogas from wastewater treatment, municipal organic waste diversion, food processing, and co-digestion; dairy and other agricultural bioenergy; and bioenergy using byproducts of sustainable forest management.
