Atascadero Community Reception Marks Official Launch of 3CE Service



On Feb. 18, community members, local officials, and stakeholders gathered in Atascadero to celebrate the official launch of Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) service in the City of Atascadero and unincorporated areas of San Luis Obispo County.

The event featured remarks from Atascadero City Manager Jim Lewis, Mayor Charles Bourbeau, Councilmember Susan Funk, and Atascadero Chamber of Commerce representative Loreli Cappel, and 3CE CEO Rob Shaw, all of whom highlighted the importance of this transition for local energy resilience, economic growth, and consumer choice.

With the addition of Atascadero and unincorporated SLO County, 3CE completes its planned service area, with 35 regional government partners in providing locally controlled, clean energy solutions. This partnership enables residents and businesses to access 3CE rebates and incentives that help electrify homes, businesses, and transportation while contributing to a sustainable and resilient energy future for the region.

This milestone represents a collective commitment to community-driven energy solutions that prioritize local investment, sustainability, and long-term economic benefits. Thank you to everyone who joined us in celebrating this exciting step forward for Atascadero and San Luis Obispo County!

3CE CEO Rob Shaw Elected CalCCA Board Chair



Last month, the California Community Choice Association (CalCCA) elected Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) chief executive officer Robert M. Shaw to chair its Board of Directors. In addition to his experience leading successful teams across a range of disciplines, Shaw is well-versed in finance, rate design, wholesale energy markets, regulatory matters, and emerging energy technologies.

Electrify Your Ride with Cash Rebates from 3CE



Transportation is the largest contributor to greenhouse gas emissions along the Central Coast. Since 2018, Central Coast Community Energy (3CE) has helped put more than 2,800 new and used electric vehicles on Central Coast roads, saving the equivalent of more than 12,000 metric tons of CO₂ emissions. Our Electrify Your Ride Program offers residential and commercial customers cash rebates for the purchase of new or pre-owned electric vehicles, Level 2 or DCFC chargers, and electrical work related to charger installation. 3CE also provides concierge technical assistance for multifamily and commercial property owners installing EV charging stations.

This year, 3CE has allocated \$4.1 million for the Electrify Your Ride Program. In fiscal 2024-25 so far, the program has distributed over \$1.2 million in rebates, enabling over \$16.1 million in electric vehicle and EV charger purchases.
